# **Cascade Falls Spring Slalom**

June 1, 2003

The Cascade Falls Spring Slalom will take place on Keuka Outlet in Pen Yan NY. Cascade Falls, a seven foot waterfall, marks the start of the competition course, which continues down stream for about 1400 feet.

The course will open Saturday, May 31, from 10am to 6pm for practice. Racers will meet on Sunday, June 1, at 8:30am with the race following immediately.

The race entry fee is \$10 for each entry with a maximum of three and the classes are the same as a all NESS events.

## **Lock 32 Whitewater Park Opening**

Final preparations are underway for Lock 32 Whitewater Park's third season. Located at 2767 Clover Street (near the corner of Jefferson Rd. and Clover St.) in Pittsford, the park offers instruction and open paddling. The season begins on May 9th and operations will continue through October 31.

A host of classes will be offered this year, including Intro To Kayaking (Level I and II), Advanced Kayaking, Play Boating (Level I and II), Rolling, and River Safety. In addition, youth camps will be held during the summer. This year there is a new rodeo hole at the last drop which is good for practicing advanced freestyle moves.

# FLOW Paddlers' Trip Roles and Responsibilities

Over the past year or so there have been a number of discussions surrounding the role and responsibilities of a FLOW Paddlers' Trip Coordinator. The discussions focused primarily on concerns regarding the following four topics:

- New and / or inexperienced boaters
- Boater safety in general
- Trip coordinator liability
- · Liability of the club

The Steering Committee has carefully considered the above and offers the following guidelines for the FLOW trip participant and the trip coordinator:

#### **Participant**

- Only paid-up FLOW members can participate in FLOW trips.
- The individual participant must sign a waiver form provided by the trip coordinator before FLOW trip starts.
- The individual participants are solely responsible their own safety and for staying together as a group during the FLOW trip.
- The individual participants are responsible for determining whether or not they are ready to participate in a FLOW trip.
- New or inexperienced boaters who have no paddling experience should obtain training from an accredited ACA instructor before participating in FLOW trips.
- The individual participants are solely responsible for providing their own safety equipment appropriate for the river difficulty, season, and weather.
- The participant is responsible for calling the trip coordinator prior to the trip and getting information on the put in, take out, and associated times - put in / take out times and places will not be published in FLOWlines.
- No one will participate in a FLOW trip unless they have contacted the trip coordinator prior to the start time of the trip.

#### **Trip Coordinator**

- The trip coordinator is also subject to participant's responsibilities 1-6.
- The trip coordinator will only allow current FLOW members to participate in a FLOW trip.
- The trip coordinator will obtain participants signatures on waiver form-before the trip starts.
- The trip coordinator will allow individuals to participate in a FLOW trip only if they have the minimum personal safety equipment appropriate for the trip.

- The trip coordinator is responsible for identifying the meeting places and times for the trip.
- The trip coordinator is responsible for canceling a scheduled trip if the conditions of the river or weather are undesirable.
- The trip coordinator will entertain phone calls from participants inquiring about the trip.
- The trip coordinator will set up necessary shuttles.
- The trip coordinator is <u>not responsible</u> for training any of the participants.
- The trip coordinator is <u>not responsible</u> for the personal safety of any trip participants.

These guidelines are consistent with the contents of the waiver form which all trip participants must sign prior to putting in. FLOW Paddlers is a social organization whose primary goal is to provide opportunities for members of the club to get together to enjoy each other's company while paddling.

## National River Cleanup Week May 10-17 2003

If you're not already in the habit, take a few hours in May and pick up trash when you are out on the river. Government agencies, paddlesports enthusiasts, outfitters, businesses, civic, and conservation groups take part in National River Cleanup Week every year. Registration is FREE and groups receive educational and promotional materials on conducting cleanups of waterways. Cleanups groups vary in size and can be as small as five or ten volunteers to groups numbering in the thousands. A trash tracking form is sent to each registered group, and is used to report on the amount and type of litter recovered. ## **FLOW Open Water Paddling**

The April FLOW General meeting was devoted to open water paddling. The meeting revealed the vast experience and knowledge that the group has collectively about paddling in many places around the country, around the world, and, most importantly, around the local area. A common desire was to be able to share in this information so that everyone had more options of where to paddle locally for a couple hours in the evening, for a day trip, or for a weekend camping trip. Interest was also expressed in finding other paddlers to boat with.

The general consensus was for one week-night paddle every week during the spring and summer; an occasional weekend day trip; and a full weekend camping trip.

The week night agreed upon was Thurs, (ADK offers trips on Wed.) It was agreed that a start time (being on the water) of 6:15 pm was convenient and offered more daylight for paddling. The difference between the arrival time at the putin and the actual start time of the trip on the water was discussed. It was agreed that the time designated in the schedule would represent the start of the actual paddling, not the arrival time at the put-in.

Two paddlers offered to coordinate an open water trip on Aug 9 & 10 for paddlers who want to attend the Annual FLOW Picnic and campfire party near Pulaski. Details will be published on the website and in Flowlines

Ed McDonald spoke about putting together another multi-day open water trip in northern Canada for 2004. Several paddlers at the meeting could attest to the great adventure these trips have afforded them in the past. Anyone interested should contact Ed at meh2.@frontiernet.net.
