Had any good swims lately? Is your C-to-C roll not reliable in your new planing hull boat? Is your new "EZ" not as easy to roll as the old RPM?

Come to the Roll Clinic at Mendon Ponds Boat Launch Thursday July 10th 6:15 PM till dusk to:

- 1. Polish up your old roll.
- 2. Learn a new roll.
- 3. Learn the difference between a bar of soap and a brick (cross section of displacement hull and planing hull cockpit).
- 4. Practice group rescues in sea/touring kayaks.
- 5. Demo a boat. Contact Wade at Oak Orchard (288-5550) or Steve at Bay Creek (288-2830) to arrange a demo. They can only bring a few boats from each store and will only bring what is requested.
- 6. Socialize on the beach.

Don't forget your bug spray! Mosquitoes are voracious at dusk while you are trying to load your boat.

Fish Creek Take-Out Landowner's Dilemma

I spoke with the land owner of the take out yesterday, and paddlers need to do something to help this guy out. The town and neighboring landowner are giving him a hard time about the paddlers at the take out.

What are the issues? People openly changing, parking on both sides of the road, and hanging out on the road slowing down traffic.

What can we do? I don't have an answer, but we should deal with it. The landowner is super nice guy, and wants to help out paddlers. Most landowners put up posted signs.

I asked what he would like us to do. He said, "The town complained about the sleds going down the sides of the road, so I built a trail through my land. Paddlers come from all over the country for this creek so I built stairs, but I have to get the town off my back. I don't want to hear anymore about it. I can't stop it, the number's increase ever year. What I'd like to do is build changing rooms down near the creek, but I'm not paying for it."

He asked if there was a club that could help or if we could get some people to pitch in, and he'd build it. I'm trying to get the word out, so we can make for a happy landowner. I'm open for ideas and more than willing to help out, we all need to put some thought into and get the ball rolling. One guy suggested planting trees, but that takes years.
