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GWC Instructional Programs

Learn to Kayak: Held at Lock 32 in Pittsford, starting mid-May to early October, every Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. with a one hour lunch break. This course offers a foundation on the basic skills of kayaking and water safety, including instruction on wet exits, forward and reverse strokes, eddy turns and river reading. The morning session is on flatwater and the afternoon session is on whitewater. Minimum age is 10 years old. Must be able to swim 25 yards. You will need a bathing suit, closed toe water shoes, a change of clothing, a towel and, depending on weather, warm clothing made of synthetic material or wool (no cotton). Bring lunch and water. Certified ACA Instructors. Cost: \$60 for flatwater session or \$99 for entire day of flatwater and whitewater. Includes all equipment. Minimum class size is 5 students. Please contact GWC at 328-3960 or www.geneseewaterways.org for more information. Youth Summer Camp: Held at Lock 32 in Pittsford, for youth 10 to 18 years old, this four day program runs Monday through Thursday with a choice of either morning or afternoon sessions. This program is an extended Learn to Kayak program, covering the same skills. Must be able to swim 25 yards and must provide own closed toe water shoes. Morning session run from 9 am. to noon and afternoon sessions are from 1 to 4 pm. Classes start the week of June 28 and continue until the week of August 23. ACA Certified Instructors. We also offer Level II of the Youth Kayak Camp, which is designed as the next step for alumni of a Level I camp or the Intro. To Kayak class. **Cost**: \$175 and includes all equipment

Forthcoming

Adult Club: For \$75 you'll get one night of instruction per week for a month. This club is designed as a comprehensive advanced class and will include a variety of topics such as playboating, practice with slalom gates, advanced paddle stokes, and surfing. The abilities and interests of the group will determine what topics are covered.

Youth Club: Same structure as the Adult Club. This program is designed to get Youth Camp Alumni back out on the water. Cost is \$75 per month for three hours per week. We provide the boat, gear and ACA instructor.

GWC Instruction on FLOW River Trips: This program is aimed at people who have taken the Intro. To Kayak class and want additional instruction on a river trip. This trip will expose you to bigger water and give you the chance to practice, get feedback and learn new techniques that will help you become comfortable on Class II-III water.GWC will provide the instructors and equipment and FLOW will provide their world-renowned sociability. The class will accompany a FLOW beginner trip and will provide the opportunity to meet other local paddlers.

FLOW-Sponsored River Safety Clinic

If you're like most of us, it's been a while since you practiced throwing your bag. This course we'll introduce and practice standard rescue philosophies and practices. We'll include swimming, rope assistance, Hand of God and basic boat recovery.



Whitewater Challengers Safety Tips

As a new season begins, Whitewater Challengers would like to remind you of some basic safety tips:

• Safety Essentials:

Whistle, Knife, Throw Bag

A kayaker should always carry these basic pieces of safety equipment when on the river.

Safety in Numbers

Always Paddle with at least two other people. Let them know where you are going.

Setting Safety

Always coordinate with everyone in your group on what they want to scout and where people would like a throw bag on shore.

• Get Your Priorities Straight

1. People 2. Boat 3. Paddle #1 means No More Victims!

Dress Ready for a Swim

This applies most to cold-water, springtime paddling. Layer up with synthetics. Hypothermia will ruin any paddling trip.

Walk If Your Gut Says "No"

If you don't feel comfortable running a section of whitewater, walk it. If you're too scared to spit, you'll probably miss your line.
